

Physical Characteristics

They can be pink, black, brown or spot. They have a snout that they use for digging for food. They have curly tails and hooved feet. A piglet is between 3 -100 pounds. A pig 100-200 pounds. A hog is up to 800 pounds.

Environment

Most pigs live on farms but some live with humans, Domesticated pigs originated from the Eurasian wild boar. A pigs pen is actually very clean.

Life Cycle

Pigs usually have 6-8 young. They have two litters a year. When pigs are first born, they have very long teeth. The mother helps to cut them away. Pigs are able to mate for 3 day periods at a time. Their pregnancy is 4 months.

What they eat

Pigs eat many varieties of food. Their snout helps them dig for food. They find grubs, roots, and corn, wheat, oats, and barley. They are also given table scraps. They eat mushrooms and truffles.

Relationship to humans.

Pigs are used for many food sources. Ham, bacon, and pork are all made from a pig. Their skin is used for leather and brushes. Pigs were domesticated 6500 years ago.
